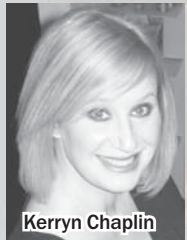

Congratulations to Kerryn who now is a mum to a bonnie baby boy born on Friday 11th of December.

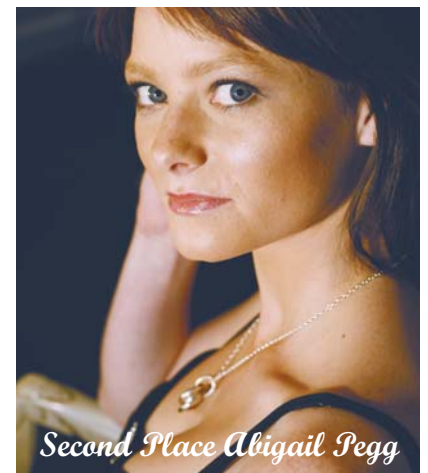
